■受講によって得られる知識・能力等

・教育目標との関連

The aim of the course is to train master's and doctoral students in scientific communication in English. The class is structured around giving presentations by each of the students, on their research projects, followed by critical discussion concerning the subject matter, including the basic reasoning behind the study, how it will be done, the expected findings, interpretation, etc.

・授業の到達目標 (Aim of Course)

One of the main shortcomings for many students (both graduate and undergraduate) in Japanese institutions (as witnessed by most professors) is the lack of student participation or involvement in class discussions. This also limits the ability of students to critically evaluate previous published research and to logically plan their own projects. The goal of this class is to actively engage students in discussions and instill in them the ability to participate in the scientific process.

■授業内容等

・授業概要 (Course Description)

Each week, one student presents their ongoing project or a research article in their field of study. This is usually a 30 min. slide presentation followed by class discussions.

・キーワード

English scientific critical discussions.

・授業計画 (Time Table)

All first year graduate (both master's and doctoral) students are eligible to enroll in the class.
